

DIMENSIONS (length, height etc)

How long is this line?



The length of this line is the distance between A and B

(you can measure it with a ruler)

Distance can be expressed in, for example:
millimetres, centimetres, metres, Kilometres
inches, feet, yards, miles

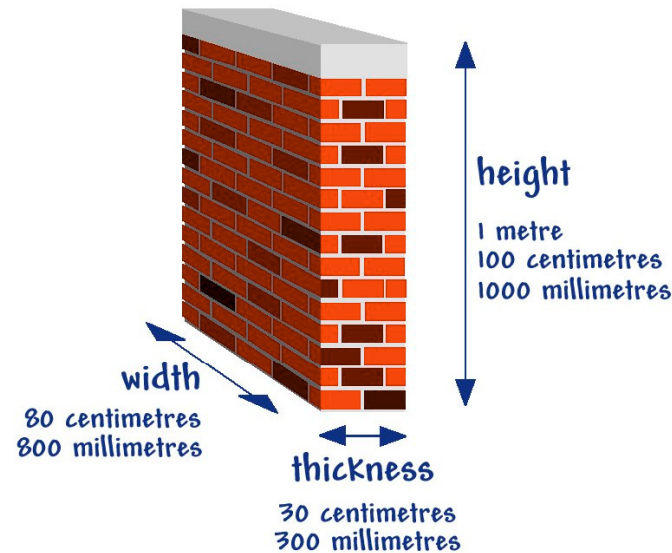
What do these symbols mean?

mm, cm, m, Km
in, ft, yd

Example: a typical door is 200 cm high, 80 cm wide and 4 cm thick

Note: length, height, width, thickness and depth (how deep something is) are all DIMENSIONS

How high (or tall) is this wall?
How wide is it?
How thick is it?



1 metre = 3 feet 3 inches approximately
1 inch = 25 millimetres approximately
